 - Unfortunately, smaller retailers have weaker cyber-security controls in place
 - If in doubt, use credit cards over debit cards! Its easier to sort out fraudulent use of credit than sorting out stolen money from your bank accounts.
 - Consumer credit laws obligate you to only \$50 of credit card fraud.
 - Clearing & Restoring your credit is much more important and costly. Insurance carriers tout Identity Theft insurnace (pays for theft) but you want insurance that includes Identity Restoration to put you back to where you were before (call us to learn more).

- > Frozen pipes can ruin your holidays. Employ these tips to help avoid an untimely loss:
 - Maintain your heat when temperatures drip into the single digits or lower, increase the temperature on your thermostadt 2-5 degrees to modulate quick temperature fluctuations
 - Open your cabinet doors to allow warm air access to sink pipes, especially those along exterior walls
 - Consider opening your faucets to a trickle so water keeps flowing through your pipes (do this to both hot and cold lines).
 - Properly insulate your home, especially gaps and crevices. Use infrared Thermal cameras to identify where your house is losing heat. Load free infrared aps on your smart phone then go outside on a cold night and see where to focus your effots.
